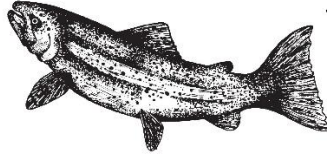


# WINES OF THE SAN JUAN

Dear Harvest Wine Festival Participant,

Thank you for choosing The Harvest Wine Festival as the place to display your talent. We are looking forward to another successful year of excellent music, food, wine, and of course, you! Below we have outlined the details regarding participation regulations, cost and set-up and break down. Please feel free to call us with any questions. 505-801-7319

Can I participate?

- Items sold in your booth must be handmade and must be made by the artist representing the booth. No items may be solely commercially made.
- You must be committed to attend all days, both days of festival in order to participate.
- All fees must be paid and application received by the deadline date of Monday, September 17<sup>th</sup>.

Cost:

- There is a \$25.00 refundable deposit. Your \$25 check will be refunded to you after your check out, at the end of the festival on Sunday evening. You must participate in the festival and check out to receive your deposit back.
- The registration fee for each 10 x 10 booth space is \$100.00, plus a deposit of \$25.00. Please send two separate checks to expedite check-out. Electricity is an additional \$10.00 for the weekend. If you need electricity please be sure to circle yes on the application. Payment is due in full, at the time you send in your application.
- Once we receive your application we will notify you by email to let you know that we have received it.

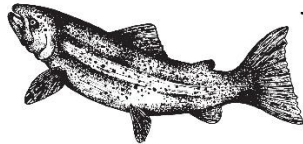
Set-up and Break-down:

- Vendor Set-up  
Friday September 27<sup>th</sup> 4-7pm & Saturday, September 28<sup>th</sup>: 8:00am-10:30am
- Don't come before 4pm on Friday, as we will be conducting normal business. You will not be allowed to set up.
- On both days of set-up, please unload your vehicle and move it to the parking area quickly, then begin set-up. It is important to keep congestion at a minimum. Everyone needs to be able get their things set-up.
- All vehicles must be removed from the festival grounds by 11:00am on Saturday. Gates open at noon.
- Vendor check-out  
At approximately 6:45pm, on Sunday, vendor check out will begin, provided guests have left the festival grounds. No vehicles are permitted into the festival ground until we make an announcement from the stage. Please clean your area and report to the kiva in order to finish check-out and receive your deposit back.
